Financing Challenges

- Budgeted planned installation program for new courts brought forward 12 months, due to accelerating deterioration of the astro courts. Current year deficit of £18k to compete this project
- Added project costs of circa £17k for new floodlight installation
- No LTA or B&NES project funding available

Funding the deficit

- Offering 2, 3 & 4 year membership offers to current members, fixing in the price to 2024-25 rates; payable in 2 parts (April & August); added security to members of a reimbursement of unused contribution, if there is a change in their circumstances.
