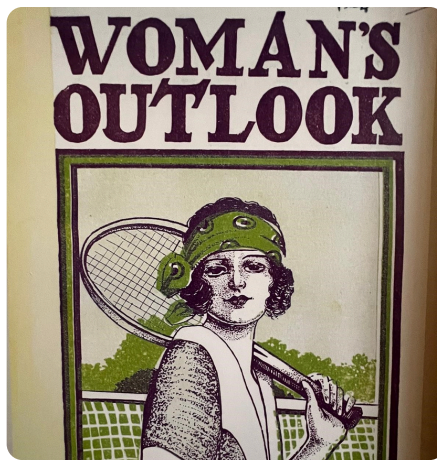
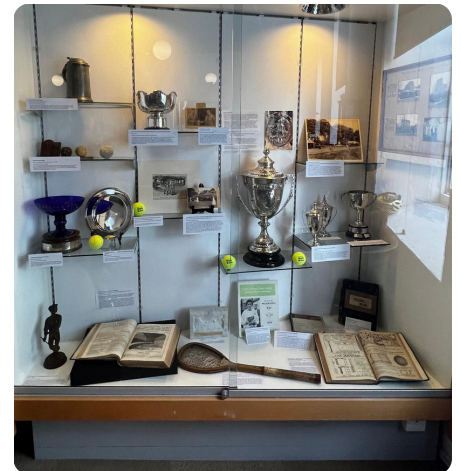
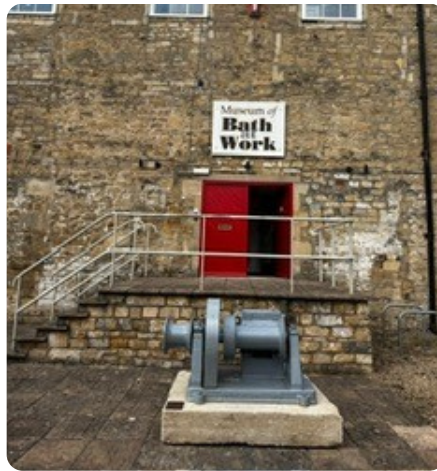
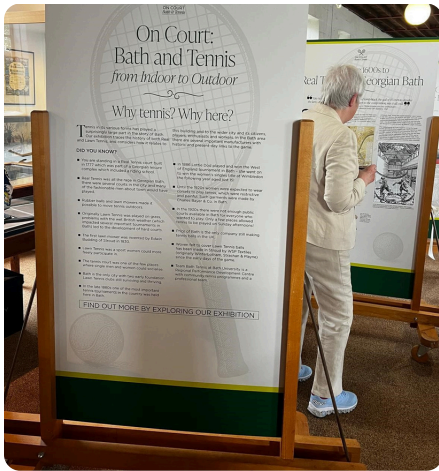


The History of Tennis in Bath Exhibition
