From Idea to £16,700: Blagdon Tennis Club's Winning Crowdfunder Journey

Earlier this year, an email from Crowdfunder led me to a webinar where a club volunteer explained how she had refurbished her cricket clubhouse through a Crowdfunder campaign. Her story inspired me to try the same for Blagdon Tennis Club.

With membership renewals approaching, I asked members if they would commit to a two- or five-year membership—an option that allowed Sport England to match the value of those fees. I estimated a realistic fundraising target (high enough to maximise match funding, but achievable), set up the Crowdfunder, and secured Sport England approval.

Before launching, I contacted local pubs, shops, tradespeople, caterers, the golf club, the vineyard, and others for donated "rewards" that supporters could buy—also eligible for match funding.

We launched on 28 March and 10 days on 8 April we hit our target!

The multi-year memberships raised £6,500, doubled to £13,000 by Sport England. Rewards and donations contributed the rest, bringing the total to £16,700—a fantastic boost for our refurbishment plans.
